

CONFLICT MINERALS POLICY

Centum Rakon India Pvt. Ltd. (CRIPI) is committed to the highest standards of Global social responsibility and will not tolerate any abuse of human rights. In this regards the Company fully supports international actions for the responsible global supply chain management of tin, tantalum, tungsten, their ores and mineral derivatives, and gold (hereafter “minerals”) and the prevention of human rights abuses in conflict-affected and high-risk areas of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and surrounding areas.

Suppliers are intimated and are expected to ensure that components and materials supplied to CRIPL are DRC conflict-free and to establish policies, due diligence frameworks and management systems, consistent with the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas, designed to accomplish this goal.

CRIPL supports the actions of the EICC and GeSI and has taken relevant steps to collect information concerning the origin of the metals that are used in components and materials supplied to the Company. Based upon information provided by the suppliers, CRIPL products do not knowingly contain metals derived from the DRC conflict region.
